Dr. Nicholas Kludt, from the Becker County DNR, presented very interesting information on Lake Sturgeon; their past and present. He also discussed modern river management and habitat projects that are supporting the return of lake sturgeon to our lakes and rivers.

Interesting points that were covered during Dr. Kludt's presentation included:

- There are nine species of lake sturgeon that are native to N. America
- Lake sturgeon are primitive fish in an evolutionary sense. They are unchanged as a species for 133 million years.
- They are very large in size. Their life span is 80 150 years.
- The female reaches sexual maturity between 20 25 years old. April 15 June 15 is the ideal time for sturgeon reproduction/spawning. They are very sensitive to human impact and need a specific habitat/environment to lay eggs.
- 1947 was the last sturgeon seen in Lake Ida.
- A stocking program began in 2022. Mature females have been found, so the plan is to stop stocking in 2023. Currently, lake sturgeon are on a catch and release ONLY basis!
- Lake sturgeon buffer the bottom of a lake against AIS!

New Business:

Treasurer's report comparing the August actual spending against the Budget was provided for all members attending the meeting. No questions were discussed.
